USEFUL INFORMATION

- Language spoken: English and Irish (Gaelic)
- · Currency: Euros
- Voltage: 230 volts. An adapter is required if you are Canadian.
- Religion: Mainly Catholic and somewhat Protestant.
- Places of worship: important to be covered at least in terms of clothing.

Gratuity:

- Restaurant: approximately 5 to 10% of the bill
- Guides: around \$10 per day
- Drivers/taxis: approximately 5 to 10%

Transport: The bus is the most used public transport in Ireland as well as the train. Taxi is also available and Uber. There are several vehicle rental centers. This is the easiest way to get around the mountains and different regions.

Cellular: You will have to see with your telephone provider before departure if packages are available to you. Otherwise, it is possible to obtain a SIM card on site.

Visa: for Canadians, no visa is necessary.

Temperature: The temperature differs from time to time. Generally cold, but in summer the day can be hot. Light and warm clothes are necessary according to the seasons. An umbrella and/or windbreaker, raincoat is necessary as there is a lot of rain in Ireland.
